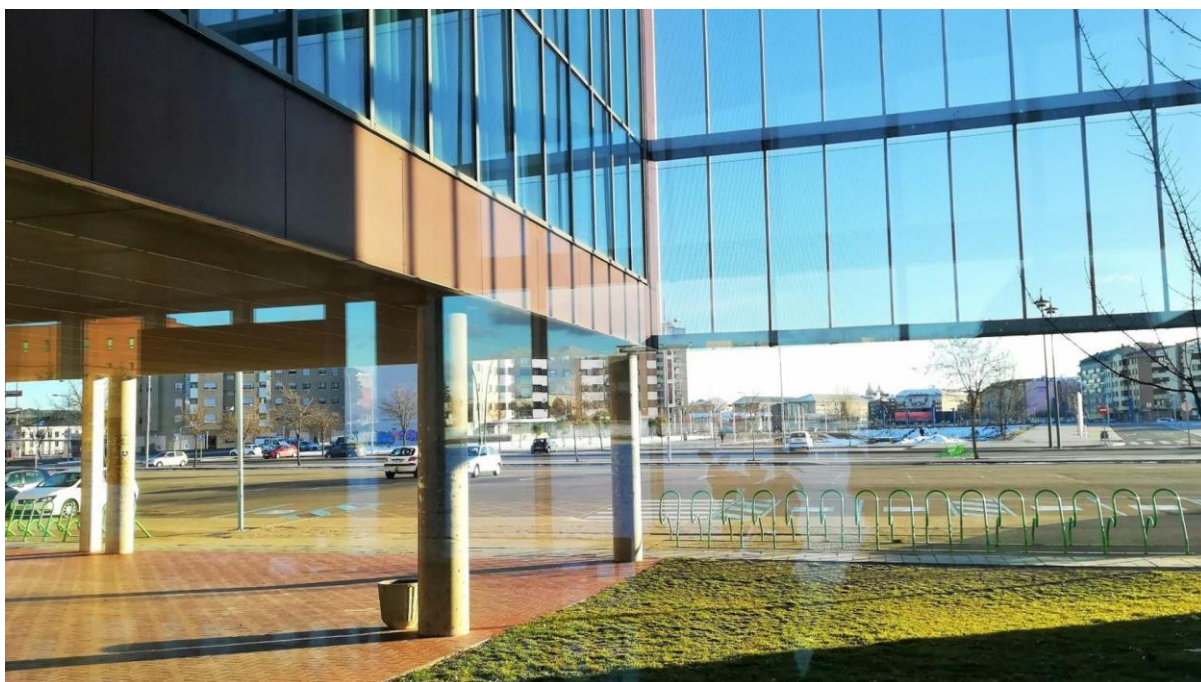

Our Academic year

- **1st semester (Winter):** From September to February.
- **2nd semester (Spring):** From February to July.

Nomination process



- **For the 1st. semester:** Nominations **before June 1st.**
- **For the 2nd. semester:** Nominations **before December 1st.**

Nominations must be done by home university personnel, completing this quick [online nomination form](#). **Nominations directly done by students will not be accepted.**

Days after the nomination, **students will receive a Registration Guide with all pertinent information.**

Registration process

- **For the 1st. semester:** Registration **before June 15th.**
- **For the 2nd. semester:** Registration **before December 15th.**

Registration will be done by the students, through our online platform (information will be sent to nominated students). They will need to collect the following documents:

- ID / Passport copy.
- Transcript of records.
- Photo
- Insurance coverage letter and payment receipt, according to the instructions from the Registration Guide.
- Learning Agreement signed, at least, by student and home coordinator.

Admission

Up to 4 weeks after the correct registration, students will receive a **Letter of Acceptance** and our International Guide with information about next steps to follow, accommodation, transportation, university services, ...

Language requirements

There is not a language certificate requirement in order to study in our Faculties. However, **we strongly recommend to have, at least, a B1 level of Spanish** and, in case the students follow courses taught in English, also a B1 level of English.
