Nomination deadline	<p><i>1st semester = fall semester</i> <i>or full academic year</i> Nomination deadline: 1 June Student application deadline : 30 June</p> <p><i>2nd semester = spring semester</i> Nomination deadline: 30 October Student application deadline : 30 November</p>
Study programmes European Credit System ECTS	<p>Licence (Bachelor): 3 years full time, 180 ECTS (credits) Master: 2 years fulltime: 120 ECTS One academic year: 60 ECTS One Semester: 30 ECTS 1 credit = 20 hours (about 10 h course time + 10h student’s individual work) ENSA Paris-Malaquais prioritises international students who commit to validate 18 ECTS minimum each semester</p>
Language proficiency	<p>IMPORTANT – Courses are taught in French</p> <p>Language proficiency in French: level B1 prior to arrival No certificate is required</p>
Insurance	<p>European Union students must have the European health card. International students must take a French student health insurance (social security) at School <u>on arrival</u> in Paris. It’s free and compulsory.</p> <p>All students have to take a civil liability insurance. It can be bought on arrival (15€). It’s compulsory.</p> <p>You can take out a complementary health insurance contract (also known as a “mutuelle”). It's optional, but recommended.</p>
Enrolment	<p>Documents required for registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - student registration form - photocopy of passport or identity card - 1 photo in JPEG format (300 Ko max) - photocopy of health card (for EU student)

Course registration	<p>All courses except 5th year courses (all courses then except semester 9 and 10 : PFE - Projet de Fin d'Etudes - courses : T9/P10/R10 and except CNAM) Licence (Bachelor) : https://paris-malaquais.archi.fr/etudes Master : https://paris-malaquais.archi.fr/etudes</p>
